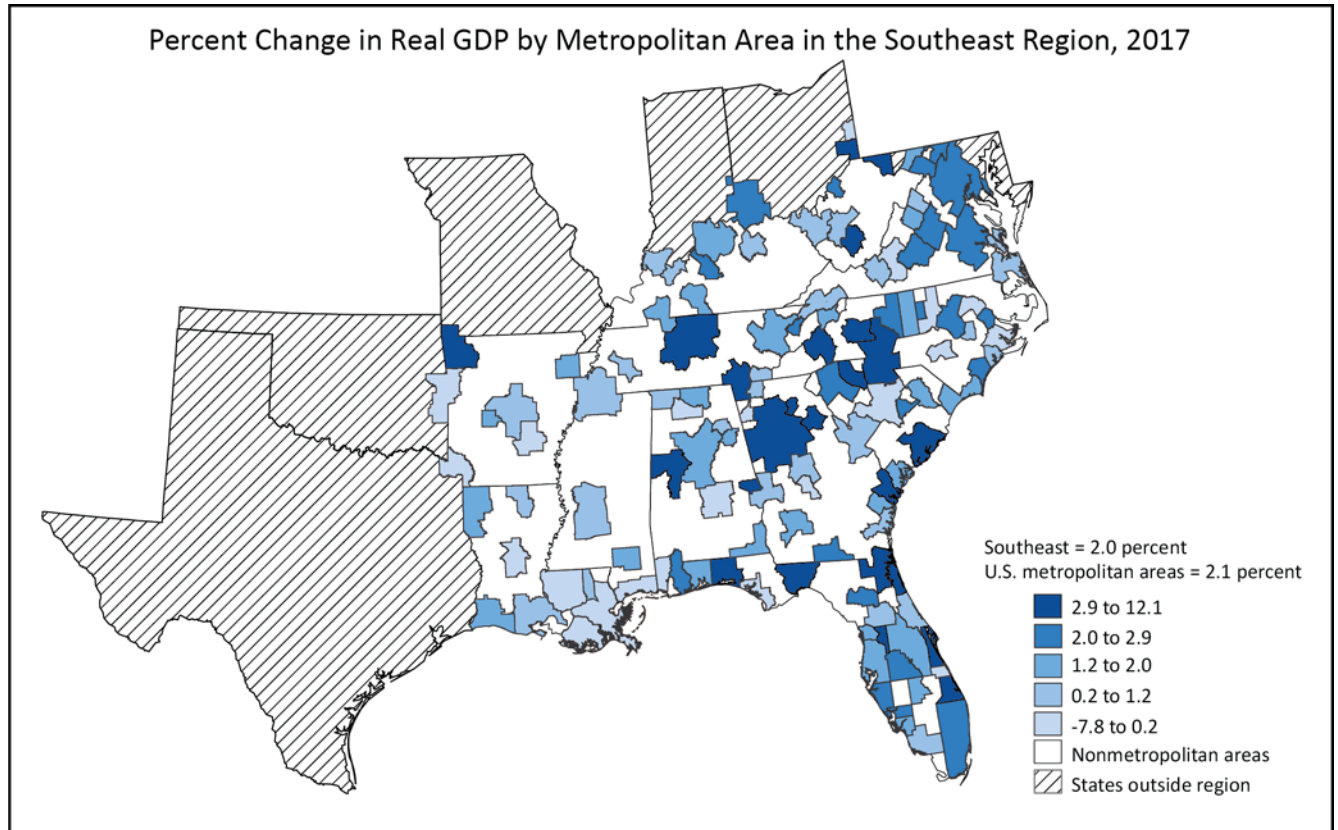


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2017

- Real GDP increased in 98 of the 114 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from 9.6 percent to -2.5 percent.
- Atlanta-Sandy Springs-Roswell, GA—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and 10th largest in the nation—increased 2.9 percent due to growth in information services.
Miami-Fort Lauderdale-West Palm Beach, FL—the 2nd largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 12th largest in the nation—increased 2.4 percent due to growth in finance, insurance, real estate, rental, and leasing.
- Per capita real GDP in the MSAs wholly contained in this region ranged from \$65,696 in Durham-Chapel Hill, NC to \$17,597 in Sebring, FL.
